Important Reminders

Make sure your student is in line on time! Our school hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 3:09 p.m.

Students are expected to line up with their class or homeroom



teacher at 8:30am on the upper school yard for morning announcements all year long (with the exception of severely inclement or freezing weather, then students will enter through the main entrance between 8:15-8:30am and be routed to different areas of the building by staff).

Breakfast is served at no charge from 8:10 a.m. to 8:25 a.m in the school cafeteria every morning. Students will then go out to the school yard to line up with their class.

Please remind your student that there is no playing on playground equipment or riding around on scooters, bikes, and skateboards in the lower school yard until 3:15pm, and

all children must have a grown-up with them.

There are no early dismissals granted after 2:30 p.m.
